		<p>2nd Lent is a time when Christians journey together towards Easter. We try and turn away from wrongdoing and ask God to help us treat other people better. This year we are thinking about justice. What do we mean by justice? (Assembly Ash Wednesday)</p>	<p>3rd On World Book Day we are going to read a story from the most important book in the Christian faith – the Bible. Listen to the story of Jesus being tempted in the desert. (Open the book assembly) Think about the things that you are sometimes tempted to do which are wrong.</p>	<p>4th Try and see the good in everyone you meet today. The Bible says that God made everyone in his image. We are all like God. Let’s see if we can find that little bit of God in everyone you see today.</p>	<p>5/6th This weekend try and do something for a member of your family. Maybe tidy your bedroom without being asked or help with clearing the table or cleaning the house. Ask your family what you can do to help and report back on Monday.</p>
<p>7th Share with others what you did to help at home this weekend. Can you continue to do that and help at home throughout the whole of lent?</p>	<p>8th Watch the news today. Notice anyone who has been treated unfairly or anyone whose freedom has been taken away. Make sure you treat everyone fairly today. (Assembly – It's not fair)</p>	<p>9th Try to notice and pay attention to every person you see or hear today. Sometimes we stop noticing other people and we don’t treat other people like we would like to be treated. God cares for everyone – try and do the same.</p>	<p>10th Listen to the story of Amos (in the open the book assembly) and think about how you can make the world a fairer place</p>	<p>11th Remember the story of Moses and how he helped the Israelites escape from slavery. Moses didn’t think he was God enough, but God promised to be with him. God will be with us too and help us to do what the right thing.</p>	<p>12/13th Ask your parents/carers if you can go shopping this weekend and buy something to bring into school for ‘Care and Share’, maybe a tin of beans or a packet of rice or pasta. Someone who does not have any food will really appreciate it. Please bring it in on Monday.</p>

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<p>14th Did you manage to buy something for Care and Share? Take some time to write a prayer for the people who will eat your food.</p>	<p>15th Try and speak to everyone in your class today when you are at break or lunch. There may be someone who you seldom speak to. Try and find something out about them.</p>	<p>16th God gave Moses a set of 10 commandments or laws to help the Israelites live a fair life. What do you think is our most important school rule? (Assembly – Rules)</p>	<p>17th Listen to the story of Zaccheus (Open the Book) and think about how he was being unfair but then he met Jesus he changed. Is there someone you need to say sorry to?</p>	<p>18th Today is Comic Relief day. Watch one of the Comic Relief films to find out how they help to bring justice into the world. Have you brought your £1 in?</p>	<p>19/20th Take some time out this weekend to be outdoors and listen to the birds. Isn't nature beautiful?</p>
<p>21st Think about the people who work in our school - not just your teachers but the cleaners the lunch time supervisors, the governors, 'Busy Bunch' and the people who cook your lunch and cut the grass. How can you show them you appreciate them?</p>	<p>22nd Talk to someone in school who you have not spoken to before, maybe a teacher who has never taught you or someone in a different class.</p>	<p>23rd Jesus made time to meet and help everyone including little children. Do something kind for someone younger than you. (Assembly Jesus and the children)</p>	<p>24th Listen to the story of the Good Samaritan (open the book). What does it mean to love your neighbour?</p>	<p>25th Do something to help someone today. You can help your teacher, your friend, someone who is feeling lonely or a member of your family.</p>	<p>26/27th This weekend is Mothering Sunday, make sure your mum or grandma has a rest on Sunday. Can you do something special for them?</p>
<p>28th Jesus brought good news to those who were suffering. Listen out for good news today. What good news can you share today?</p>	<p>29th Today the year 5 and 6 choir are going to London to sing in the Royal Albert Hall. Singing is a wonderful way of bringing people together. Make a class list of your favourite songs that you like singing at school.</p>	<p>30th Listen to the story of how Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and everyone shouted and cheered. (Palm Sunday assembly)</p>	<p>31st Listen to the story of how Jesus washed his disciples' feet. (Open the Book). Jesus showed his friends how they should serve others. What can you do today to serve or help someone.</p>	<p>1st Think about who or what is important in your life? Ask your friends and family what is important to them. Are some things more important than money and things?</p>	<p>2/3rd Have a turn out of your old toys and books that you no longer play with. Is there someone you can give them to who might enjoy them? If not take them to a charity shop so other people can make use of them.</p>

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<p>4th Say thank you to someone today for what they have done or do for you. Remember to say thank you to your teacher as you leave the classroom this afternoon.</p>	<p>5th Jesus always helped people who needed a friend, He encouraged us to do the same. Look out for anyone who is alone at lunch or break time today. Goo and talk to them and invite them to play with you.</p>	<p>6th Today is our Easter service. Let’s be grateful that we can meet in Church again. The last two years have had to be online. Look around the church and appreciate all that you see.</p>	<p>7th Listen to the story of Easter (open the book) and reflect on the unkindness that Jesus experienced on that first Easter.</p>	<p>8th Say the Lords Prayer together and reflect on what it means to pray to God and to say that prayer that Jesus taught us together.</p>	<p>9/10th This is the first weekend of the Easter holidays. Think about how you can make this school holiday happy for your family and yourself.</p>
<p>11th This week is what Christians call Holy week. Make a special effort this week to think about other people and how you can care for them.</p>	<p>12th Make a small gift or card to give someone on Easter Sunday.</p>	<p>13th Take some time to go outside for a walk or a run and breath the fresh air. Thank God for our wonderful world.</p>	<p>14th Today is the day when Jesus shared the special meal with his friends. Enjoy special time with your family as you eat together and offer to help with the preparation of the meal or the clearing up.</p>	<p>15th Today is Good Friday the day when Christians remember Jesus suffering on the cross.
