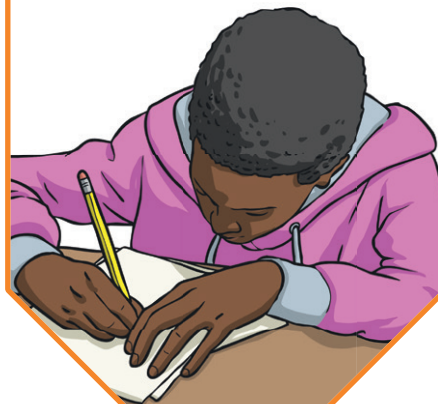


Words

- Find a word you don't know and look up the meaning in a dictionary.

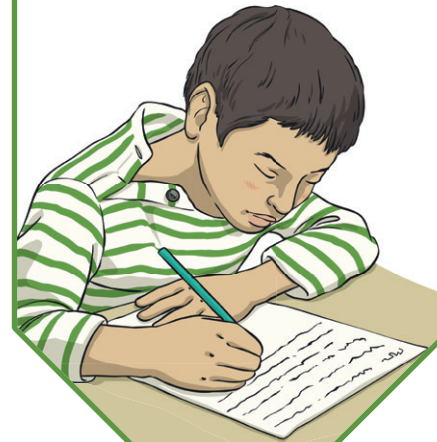
Characters

Language

- Find a word that caught your attention and say why.
- Find a phrase that caught your attention and say why.
- Find a word of which you weren't sure of the meaning but worked it out. How did you use context to work it out? Talk me through your strategy.



Reaction

- Say what you like and don't like about this text and give reasons why.
- Tell me about a book you have enjoyed and give reasons for your opinion.
- Ask a question to help you understand the text better.
- What would you say politely to someone who disagreed with your opinion of this book?



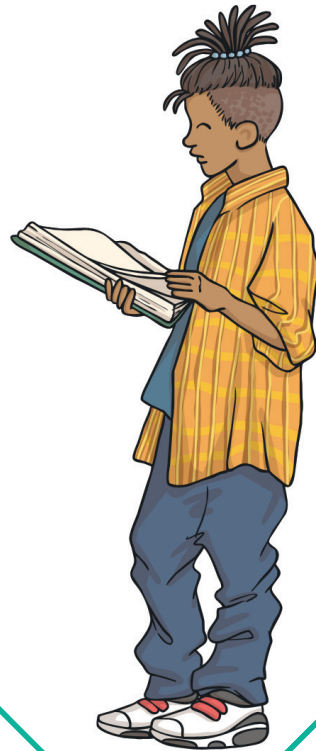
Content

Retelling
