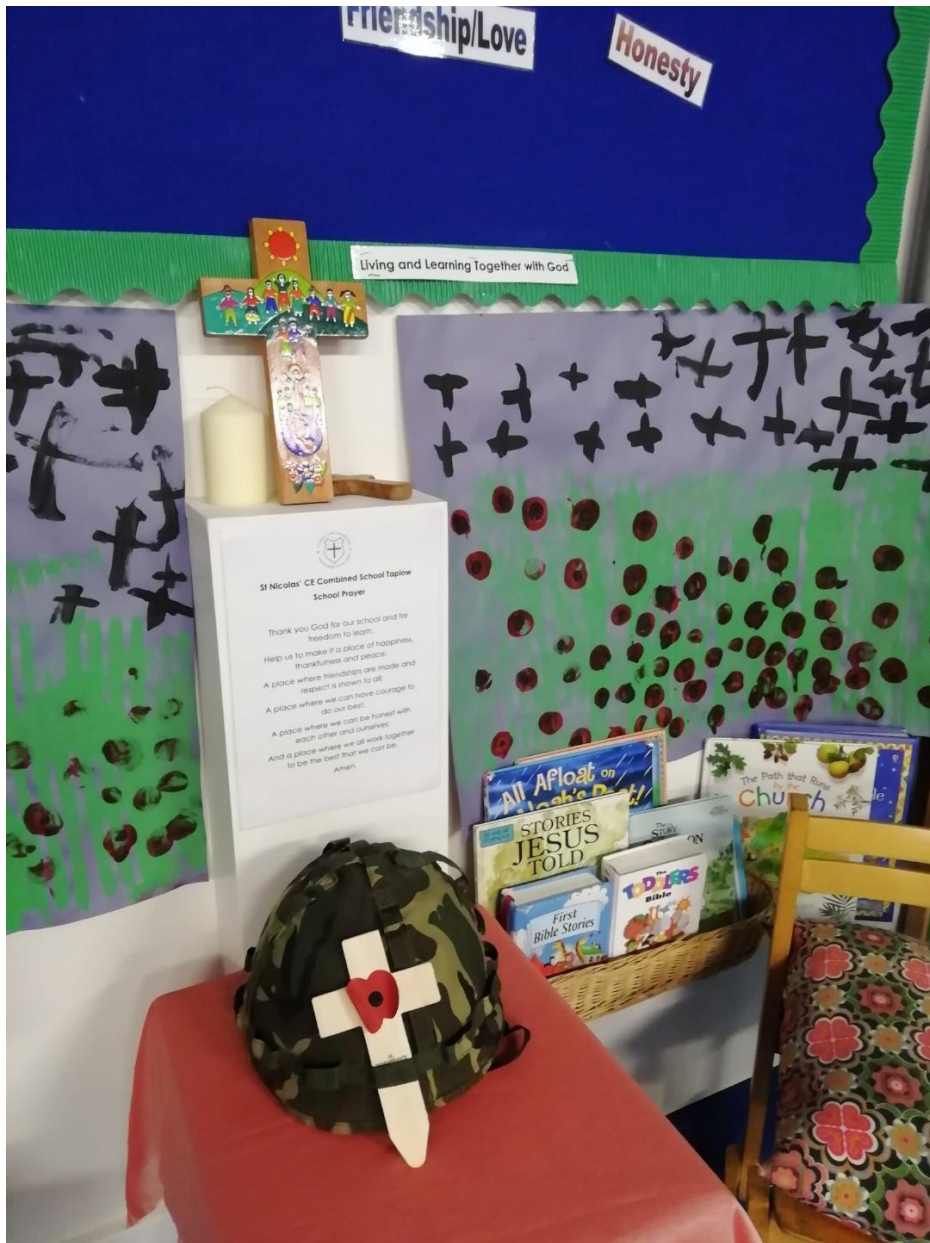
You will be given your own mini beast carpet space to sit on. This will change regularly so you can sit in different places and make new friends.

garden.



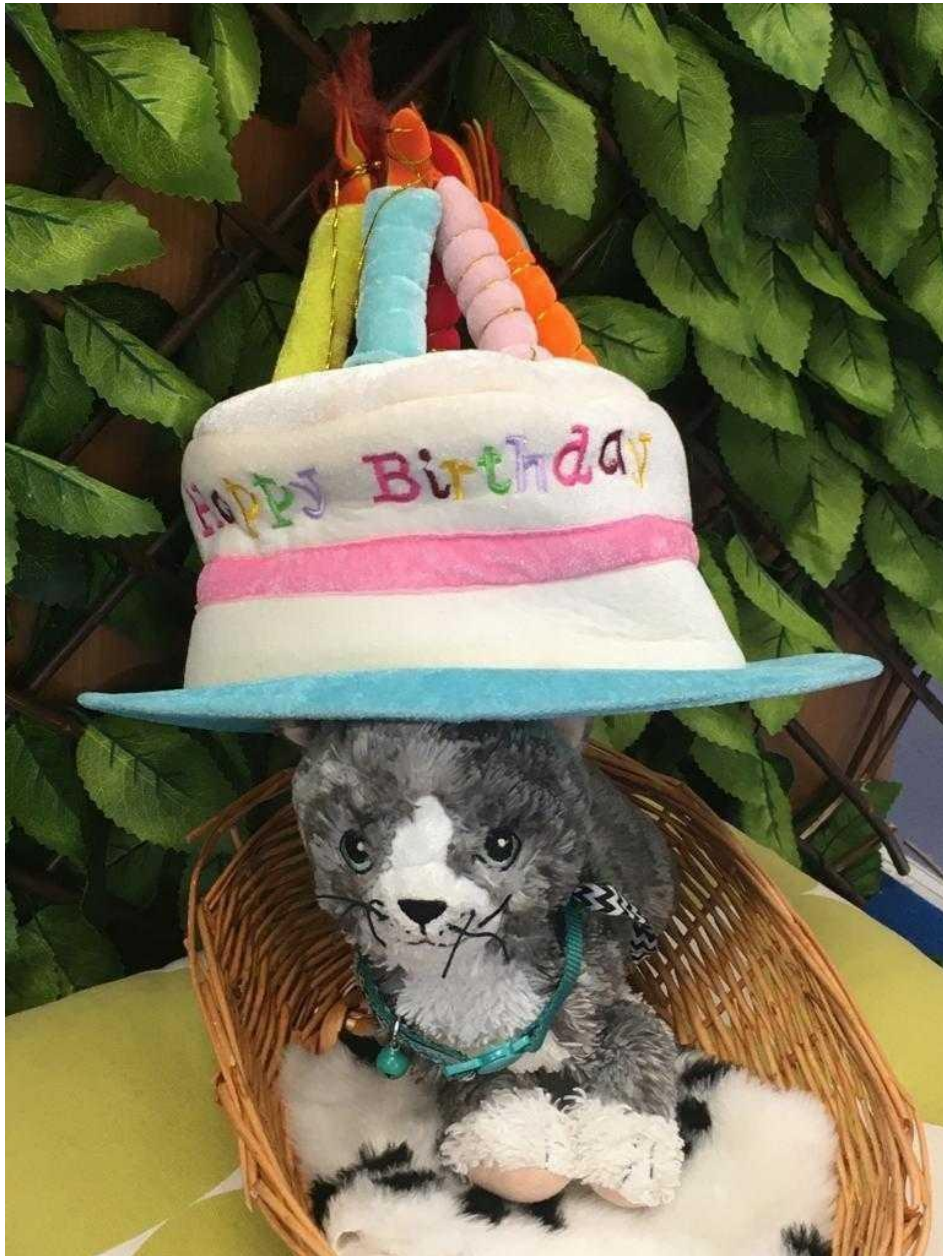
Can you see the
