## National Curriculum Objectives:

## Differentiation:

### Beginner

Eleven spellings split into blocks of five and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Aimed at Year 5 Emerging.

### Easy

Eleven spellings split into blocks of five and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks have jumbled letters. Aimed at Year 5 Developing.

### Tricky

Eleven spellings split into blocks of five and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. One or two letters given in each spelling as a clue. Aimed at Year 5 Secure/Year 6 Emerging.

### Expert

Eleven spellings with one word bank. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. Aimed at Year 6 Developing.

### Brainbox

Eleven spellings with one word bank. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. Aimed at Year 6 Secure.

### Genius

Eleven spellings without a word bank. Aimed at Year 6 Mastery.
