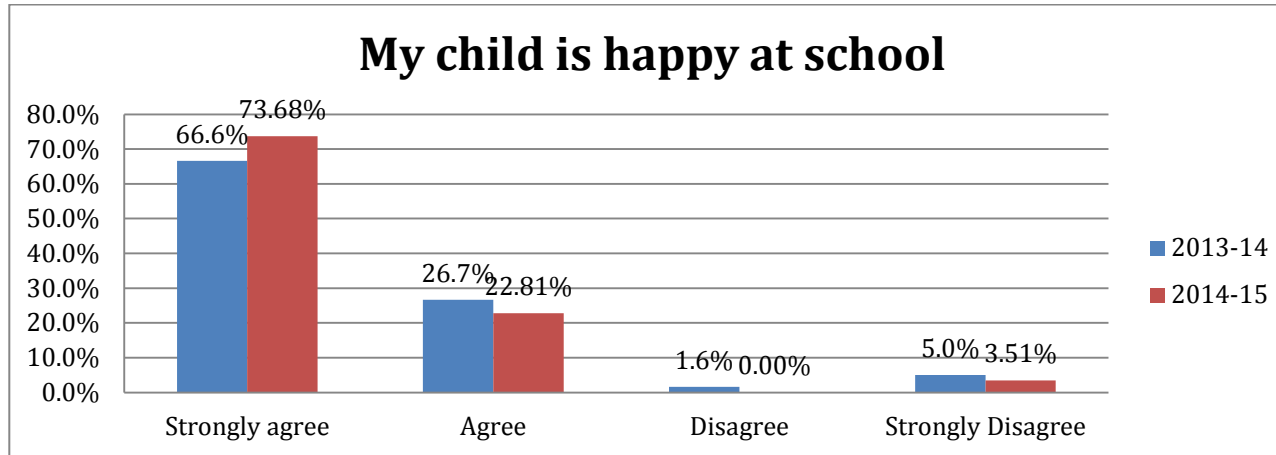
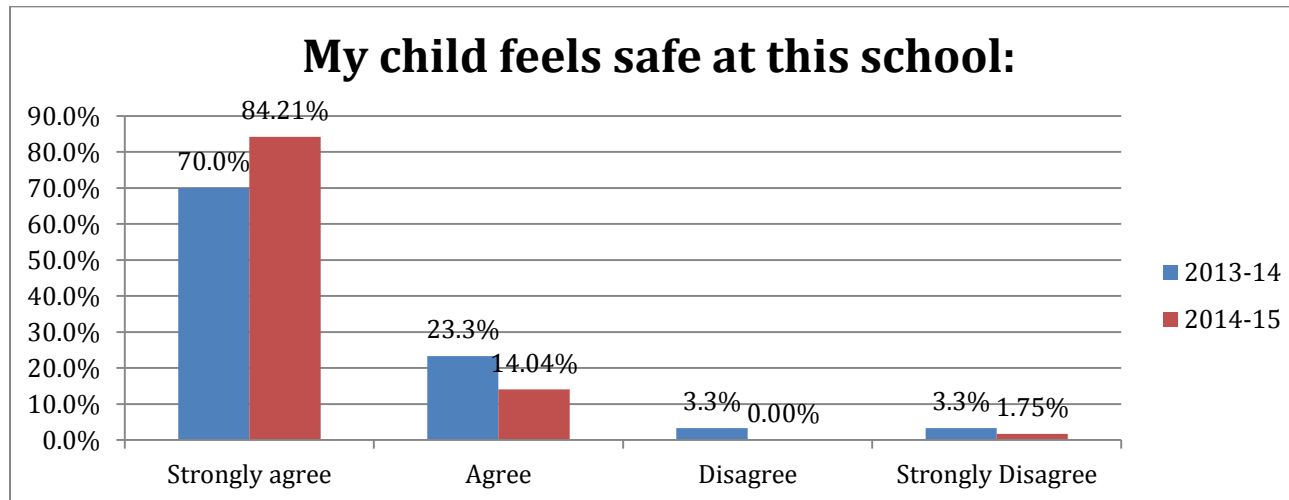


## Parents' Survey Comparison 2013-14 and 2014-15

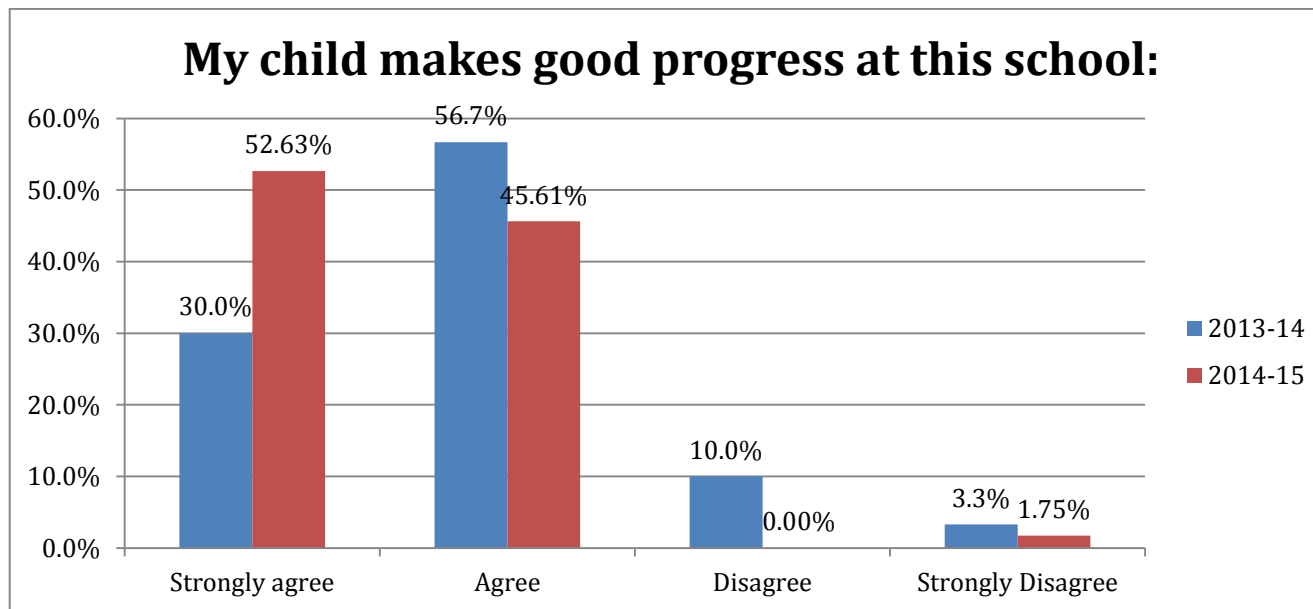
Thank you to all of the people who took time to fill in our Parents' survey, below is a comparison between the last two years' surveys. We are very happy with the results, thank you!



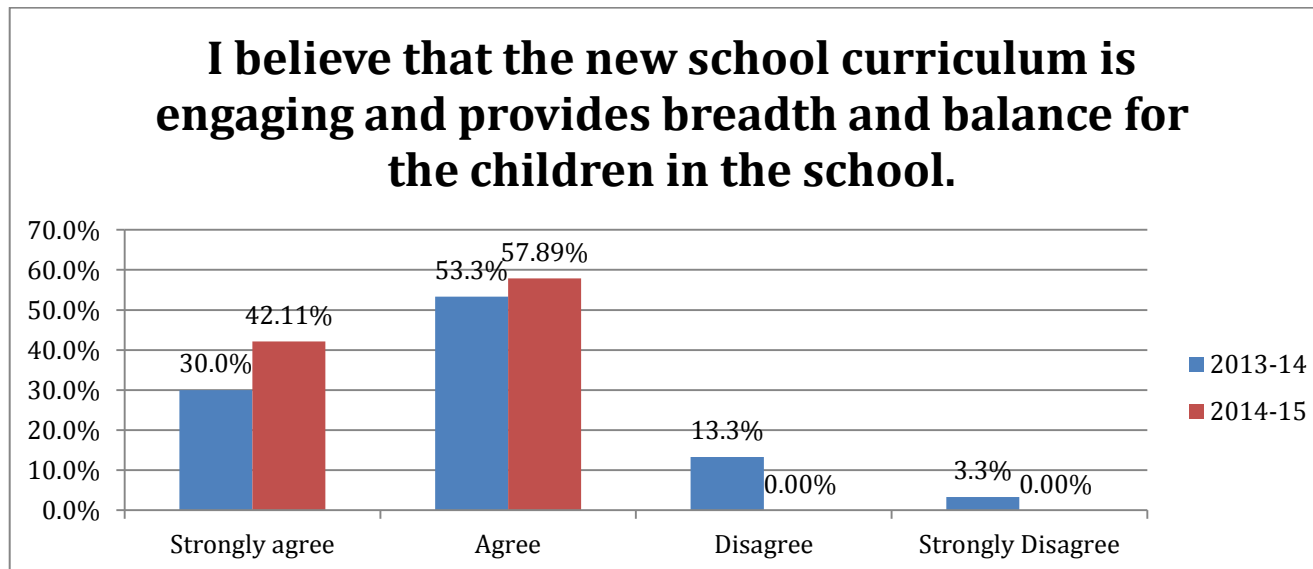
It is pleasing to see an increase in the percentages of children who were happy at school, particularly with those who strongly agreed.



Again pleasing increases in the percentages of those children who feel safe at school, with 98% of all respondents feeling that way.

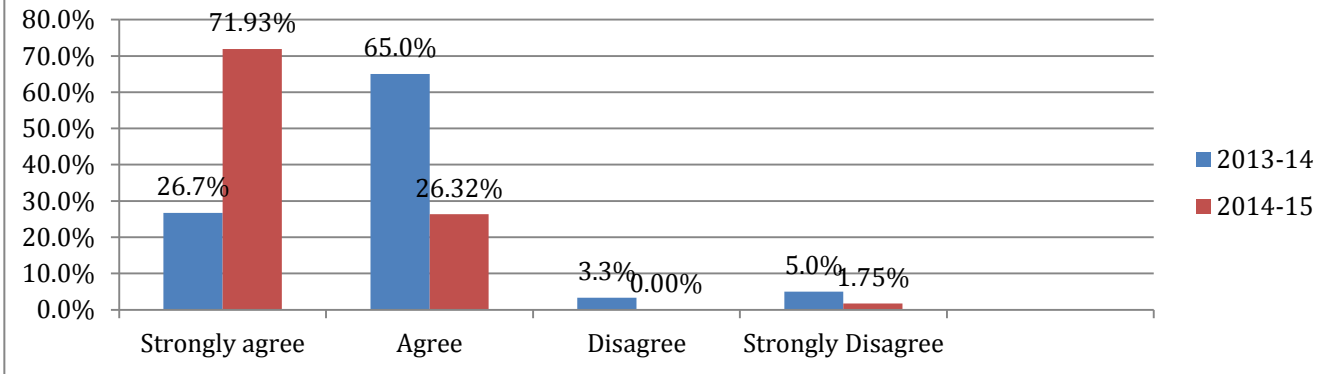


Once more it is good to see that the perception of progress has improved. With 98% agreeing that their child makes good progress compared to 87% last year.



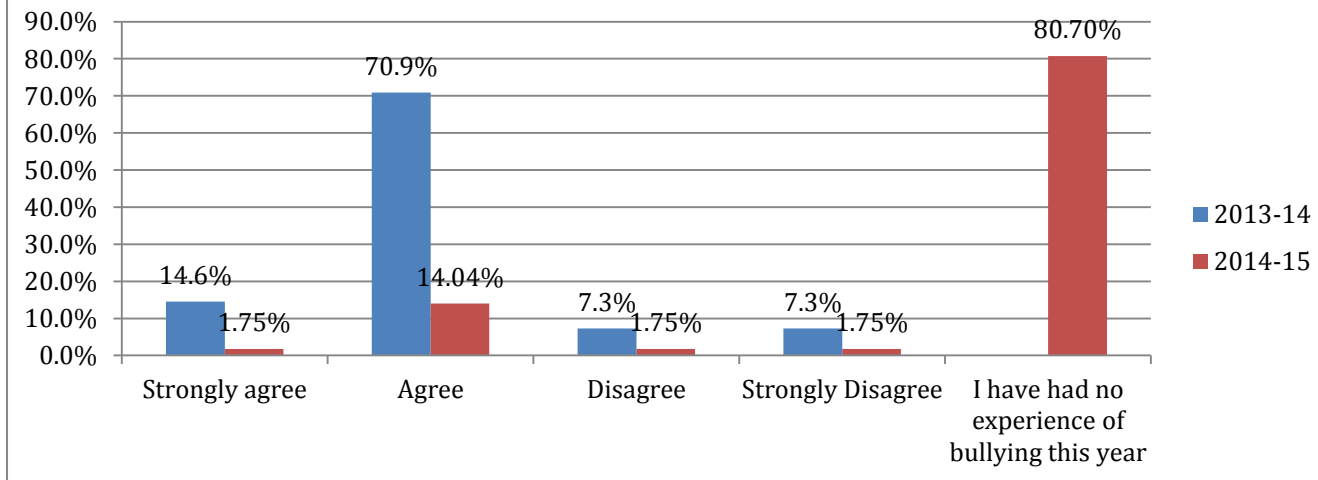
Further improvements in the belief that the curriculum is engaging, providing breadth and balance for the children this year with 100% of the respondents agreeing with the statement compared to 83% last year. We are particularly happy with this result as we have spent a lot of time focusing on this area of school life.

## The school ensures that the pupils are well behaved:

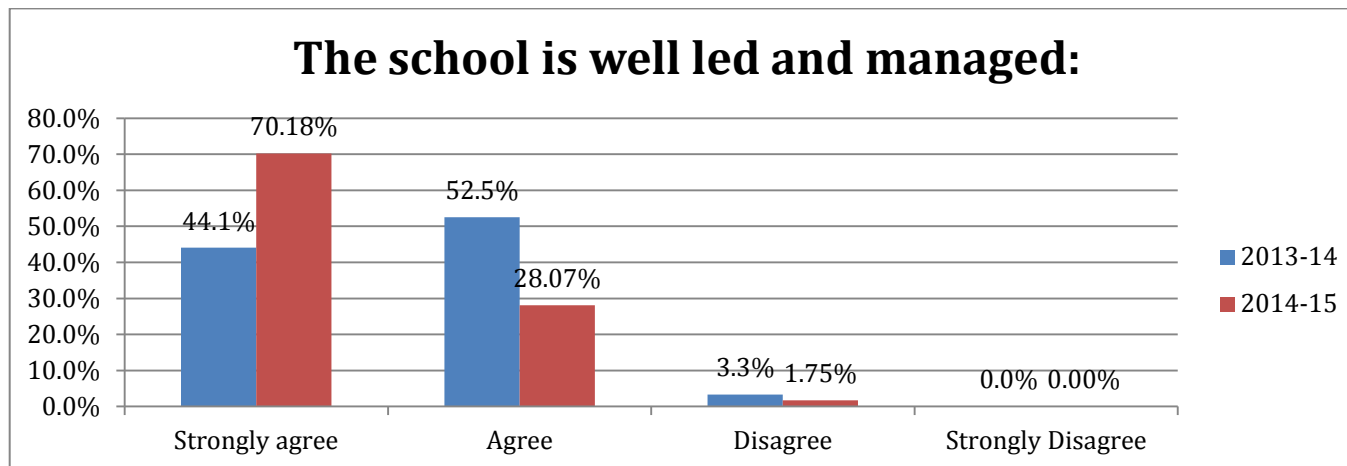

With 72% strongly agreeing compared to 27% last year this is a real change.

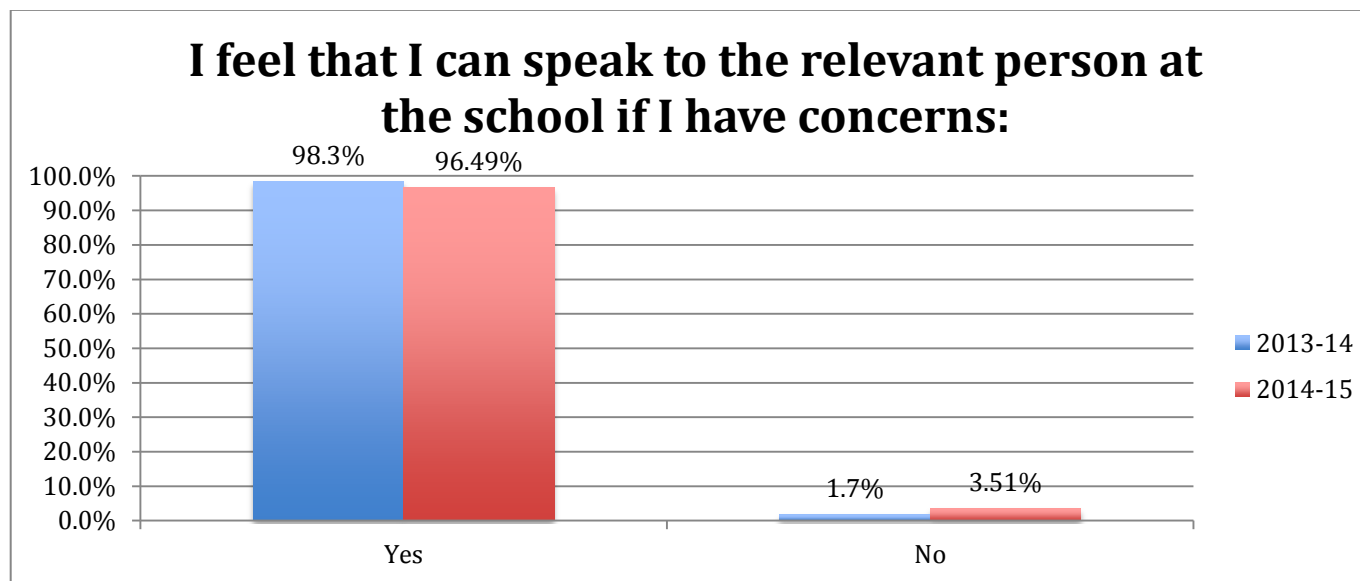
## The schools deals effectively with bullying:



This question was altered slightly following last year's survey, as many people commented that they had had no experience of bullying at St Nicolas'. Whilst we are pleased to hear this, we do take each and every single report of bullying incredibly seriously and follow it up through our behaviour policy and working with any individuals concerned.



Another question showing improvements in the Strongly Agree section with an increase from 44% to 70% and 98% agreeing overall.
