Maths

Please continue to ensure that you are confident and speedy with your number bonds to 10 and 20.

Practise counting up to 50 and writing these numbers.

There are also some maths activities that you can choose, see the maths activity file.

This week we have been counting in 2s, 10s and 5s. The attached workbook has a range of activities to consolidate your counting skills.

English

Think of the book we have just read – The Most Important Animal of all. Research an animal of your choice and create a factual report similar to the ones that we have read about.

Please practise the common exception words that are in your home learning book.

Please also practise your phonics. There are some phonics activities attached.

In geography we are learning about coasts. Write some sentences to describe a British beach. What would you see?

This week we have been learning to use the conjunctions 'so' and 'because'. Practise writing some sentences with these conjunctions.

History
